



## Driver Briefing Notes 2007

### Viewmont

#### SS 13 Mud Bath

##### Start

- Start 08:30 finish at 11:30
- Vehicles will start and we will start the second car after the first has cleared the first obstacle (we expect to start a new vehicle after 10 mins)
- Start order is established through a random draw at driver brief
- Start will be 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 Go. You will leave on go.

##### Objective

- To traverse through the water/mud from start to finish using GPS references in the best possible time with the least penalties.

##### DNF Time

- The DNF time for this event is 45 mins

##### Points

- Maximum points available for this stage are 100 points.

##### Parc Ferme Instructions

- When you finish you must immediately proceed to the Parc ferme where you will not be permitted to work on your vehicle and where your vehicle must remain until the last vehicle has finished the SS.

##### • Instructions/Rules of this SS

- Complete the course as outlined by the marshal at the start line
- GPS reading is WGS 84
- At the entrance to obstacles (water/mudhole) and occasionally within the obstacle there could be gate signs. You must always go between the gate signs wherever they are or you are outside the course.
- The finish is a flying finish
- If you breakdown during this SS or have any emergency situation the radio channel used for communications on this SS is UHF channel 14
- The co-driver can get out of the vehicle and guide the driver through.

- SS is completed unloaded (note compulsory equipment must be carried)
- Note it is your responsibility to drive safely and be aware of other competitors.
- Competitors must stay well away from stock watering dams on the property.
- Be warned that safety is paramount
- When you finish you must immediately proceed to the Parc ferme where the officials will give you further instructions
