ARB Warn Outback 4x4 Challenge

Wet weather plan is continuing for the ARB Warn Outback 4x4 Challenge until further notice.

Following on from the bulletin Tuesday at 13:00, Wednesday stages as listed in the original schedule have been postponed.

The Silver City Highway north towards Packsaddle has been reopened, as has the Corona Road so competitors will finish their stages at Nundooka and Poolamacca and head south to Broken Hill ready to head to their special stages at Viewmont and Denian tonight.

All competition stages are running but they are not running to the time schedule released at the start of the event. At this stage, no special stages have been withdrawn with the exception of the Wednesday stages 1, 2 and 3 which have been postponed.

The weather forecast is good for the rest of the competition and we expect the road to the other two areas to reopen today and we will transport competitors to their special stage areas as per the original schedule Wednesday night.

We will access the road closures situation with the appropriate authorities this morning and release another bulletin during the day for all participants unless we receive information earlier.

This is a reminder that any persons, marshals, spectators or competitors, who disobey instructions either from event leaders or local authorities regarding road closures may be subject to heavy fines and will be prohibited from any future involvement in the event.
